PARK(ing) Day **Friday, September 20, 2019**

Jackson Hole Public Art (JHPA) is hosting PARK(ing) Day on Friday, September 20, 2019. PARK(ing) Day occurs annually across the world and this will be the fourth year of this event in Jackson Hole. Local creatives install unique parklettes that will occupy parking spaces in downtown Jackson for one day only. PARKing Day demonstrates how we can transform a mundane parking spot into a place of possibility. On PARKing Day maps that showcase the location of each installation are shared so pedestrians can enjoy a self-guided art walk in downtown Jackson.

Participants: Participants should have the experience and abilities to design and build a temporary installation. Artists are responsible for showing up on time to install on the day of the event, manning the site for the day (or having volunteers there when you leave), and removal of their work at the end of the day. Installations should be safe (no sharp objects, nothing top-heavy that could fall on people), family friendly (rated PG), and able to withstand public interaction for one day.

JH Public Art: We will review your concepts as they come in; provide feedback, event coordination, special event permits, and marketing. We will bring you lunch and cold drinks during the day. We will contact all affected businesses to ensure we have their support before using a parking space.

Rolling Timeline:

Introductory meeting July 2nd, 5:00 – 6:00 pm

We will review your concepts as they come in and award PARKing spots in a first-come, first served basis. We will not accept concepts after July 31st, 5:00 pm.

Participants will be announced between July 15 and August 5.

Progress checks: mid-August – September 18.

Install: between 9 and 10 am on September 20th.

***New this year - Center Street Placemaking and Age-Friendly Installations**

In 2020 the Center Street water line needs to be replaced. In collaboration with the Town of Jackson, JH Public Art is hoping to test creative placemaking ideas that may be used to mitigate the negative impacts of the construction project during PARKing Day. We have applied for grants that would be used to address the following issues in a creative way: way-finding (to restrooms, public transportation) and Trishaw bike parking, age-friendly seating and activities, ADA access to walkways, and moveable planters. If anyone is interested in integrating any of these elements into PARKing Day please let us know.
